Potatoes, meet Waffle Maker

Your bubby might be confused by this one—are they waffles?

Are they latkes? Rachel says, "They're the best of both worlds." Say goodbye to hours of standing over a frying pan, and say hello to a new Chanukah tradition.

RECIPE BY RACHEL GOLDZAL

Latke Waffles



5 lb. potatoes



2 medium onions



5 eggs



½ cup oil



1½ cups plain breadcrumbs

2 cups shredded cheese





Cooking spray

- Peel potatoes and onions
- Place in a food processor until blended
- Add the rest of the ingredients and mix
- Preheat waffle maker and spray with oil
- Place ½ cup of batter in the center of the waffle maker
- Cook for 6-8 minutes, until golden brown

Scallion Sour Cream



16 oz. sour cream



€ 1 bunch scallions



1tsp. salt



→1 tsp. paprika

- Place all ingredients food processor
- Blend until smooth

The closeness that we have. Once you meet someone else that's Jewish there is such a strong connection.


If you could have lunch with any Jewish person throughout history—past or present, who would it be?







Students in **Loudon County, VA**, entered a Kiddush factory, where they made grape juice and learned all about the Kiddush blessing which is said at the beginning of Shabbat.





Different Dreidels
